As usual, there are books that somehow fulfil all the expectations that you have. This book is like a reverse version, it has **nothing you wanted but everything you did not want**.

Not once was there a scene, in which reading it, he felt genuinely remorseful for his actions. Furthermore, he is a real class act. But the **best friend is the absolute worst of this novel**, which is very unexpected. Most expectations are at the main couple, the function of the best friend is to be an emotional support and occasionally drive the plot when necessary. Furthermore, although it is not solely Summer, the best friend, who does it, but she embodies many questionable morals.
