Primarily a tale of obsessional and fusional love, independent of categorisations (gay/bi/straight), a love that transcends moral codes and Chinese society's conformity, and forces the couple (both male) into extremes of behaviour and actions. This tale of obsessive love is reminiscent of the movie "L'Empire des sens" (Realm of the senses) by a Japanese director, whose name escapes me at the moment. If you have seen that movie (uncut version of course) and liked it, then you might like this book. Despite the serious theme, the book is not depressing. It is often hilarious, with greatly exaggerated situations and even cartoonish at times. The author expertly alternates comedy and tragedy, goofiness and realism, fluffy romance and dark twisted lovesickness.

This is definitely the kind of story especially meant for lovers of the BL/yaoi crowd as it contains all the tropes that we are familiar with. But for those who are not into yaoi, then read with caution lol. Or better, watch the "Addicted" web series (free on You Tube), it is way 'tamer' than the novel, and might interest you enough to read the novel after. The web series is well done, with great acting, and good chemistry between the 2 leads and some good insights into Chinese culture.
