This may be as a result of binge watching CinemaSins, but some key things happen in this book without any explanation for the timeline. *Spoilers*

1. Clearly Slade knew where Josh lives, so why did he wait til Josh was hosting 4 Alphas to bother him?
2. He had plenty of opportunities to capture Josh with zero interference from the others, but didn't, like when Josh and Bry were in the forest and Bry left him there (*OR LITERALLY ANY OTHER TIME BEFORE THE ALPHAS ARRIVED*). Does he just like a challenge?
3. If all Slade wanted was an heir, why not impregnate the other Omegas who were supposedly fawning over him? It took him 7 years to come to this decision? Plus he clearly didn't care if it was Jacob or not, and he was willing to wait for Josh to carry to term, so literally *any* other Omega would do.

I'm underwhelmed and considering abandoning Omegaverse books altogether. They're always either being rescued from sex trade or running away from abusive Alphas. I need to be wowed.
