Dick Anderson knows he screwed up. He tried to be someone he wasn't so he could ease Jane into the lifestyle that he lives. When she breaks up with him for being boring he vows to get her back and show her just how Dominate he is.

This is one of those novellas that reads like a full length novel. The emotions that are evoked are so real and complex and very relatable. This story really brings into light the need for complete trust in a D/s relationship. Not only in your partner but in yourself as well. Having been raised in a less than nurturing environment Jane struggles with self-esteem issues and this makes it harder for her to give herself fully to Dick, to believe that he will accept her for her.
