There were so many little things I appreciated in this book. First, the relationship between Marc and Lauren was so genuine and honest. (eg. Marc didn't try to hide the fact that he had placed a bet with his friend to see if he could get Lauren to do the bet.) Second, I just really liked how sensitive Marc was to Lauren's needs. It was so sweet how he was constantly in tune with what she needed like a true dom. Third, the author really cares about the safety of the subs. There're a lot of books with bdsm out there that just ignore the safety precautions, so it was refreshing to see.

I didn't like that the author had to explain why Lauren was a domme, but I understood it and I loved Marc's reason for being a dom. (No need for explanations. He was just born that way.) Also, for some reason, the author switched (no pun intended) pov's constantly (almost every scene).

Warning: Lauren whips and spanks other women, so if you don't like that kind of stuff, then stay away.

I'd actually like to round up to 3.5 stars, maybe even 4. There's a whole lot of cliche going on in parts (particularly the dialogue the beginning & end) but the middle really surprised me. There's a small handful of stories I can think of that really educated me on what it means to be a Dom/me or a sub, and this was one of them. I expected to find a fun little read with a fair amount of smut sandwiched between a few plot-advancing scenes, and instead I found some really great exploration of what it means to be a sub, a Dom, or even a switch. Granted, I don't live the lifestyle, so I take it all with a grain of salt and suspect that Ms. Evers greatly over-simplifies Lauren's exploration & quick acceptance of her new-found submissive side. However, woven in between some eye-rollingly stereotypical setting details (billionaires! private planes! dom perignon!), Marc & Lauren gave a refreshing look at the roles of Dom & sub as they worked out the kinks (heh) in their relationship. I liked their camaraderie, I liked their ease with one another, and enjoyed seeing their mutual respect grow into something more.

I also found Roman's trip to Japan & his subsequent night with Jade very fascinating. Evers writes some really steamy smut, and I will say that Roman's scene with Jade was some of the most unique sex I've ever read. Needless to say I'll be heading over to Google in a bit to explore the topic of Shibari sometime soon.

This was indeed a quick, fun read - with a bit extra. A marked improvement over the first book in this trilogy, I'm definitely putting the third on my TBR list.

Another unbelievable book by Shoshanna Evers that leaves you breathless and waiting for the 3rd and final book in the Enslaved Trilogy. A Dominant and a Dominatrix – together. Who will top – what will happen to the person on the bottom. True Love or resentment?

Marc Wilde has been attracted to Mistress Lauren since he first laid eyes on her at Whippersnapper. She's one of his best friends, besides Trevor and Roman, beautiful, fun and she's a well respected Dominatrix and he is in no way a Submissive. But, Roman feels that every person has a little submissiveness in them – including Mistress Lauren. So tonight, at Trevor's bachelor party and with Roman's prodding, he makes a

bet with Mistress Lauren ... whoever losses the bet has to be the others submissive for a week. Let the games begin!

Mistress Lauren knows that if there is any man that she would want freely to be with, it would be Marc. She loves her time with him – laughing, having a good time, just talking. But, her past will not allow her to just submit to any man. It's her way or no way. Until she looses the bet. But, can she willingly let go of her self and commit totally to Marc as his Submissive. There has to be a way for her to get through this without losing herself to a man again. She asks Marc to just try to submit to her once but it fails miserably. Marc cannot stand the thought of Lauren being with another man. He's been in love with her for a long time and now he needs to make her his. Put his mark on her. Make her his Submissive. My Thoughts

I always enjoy getting to know the boys in a trio – and in this instance, we finally get to learn more about Marc – the tattooed, shaven head one....and at the same time we get to learn quite a bit more about Mistress Lauren – whom we were just teased a bit about in book 1.

This story picks up on the eve of Trevor and Elisabeth's wedding, an even that we can only expect will be complicated given Roman's feelings for Elisabeth. That plays out interestingly in this story, but it's really Marc that we should get back to.

What we find out is that Marc and Lauren have been 'besties' for more than 5 years, really leaning on each other for support for any number of reasons, but because they are both doms, they can't ever really cross that line. Everyone of course sees the way that they are with each other, and it's after Roman suggests a bet to Marc that will cause them to cross the line, that we see things evolve and change. The bet of course is to see who can get a sub to scream first, and the loser then has to sub for the winner for a full week.

Marc finds a way to win the bet, and that means that Mistress Lauren will have to submit for a week. If she's able to that is. Where this story takes us is on that journey, where we learn more about why she became a domme, and what it means for her to submit to someone, and try to relinquish control – which she doesn't truly do for the most part in this story.

What i liked here is that we continue to see the SM side of BDSM in this series, which we don't get to see as often in this genre. We see Marc who's all tough nails find his compassionate side especially since he finally admits that he's in deeper with Lauren. He's even willing to submit to her if that helps things – but it's a battle of wills with them.

What we're continuously asking ourselves in this story is whether Marc's desire to be with Lauren means that he'll find a way to successfully top her, or if he'll find a way to be her sub if it means that things will work out. I have to say that where they finally netted out was a nice twist on things, given how macho we get a sense of Marc being.

I have to say that Marc knows what he's doing with heat and passion when he's trying to top someone. We get to see him be powerful and authoritative with Lauren and it's hot. very hot. there's a clear chemistry with them, and because they are both so alpha, it makes each scene that much more intense, sexy, and heated.

The other nice thing is that like we had in the first book, we get a really good path to where the 3rd book will take us. We know that Roman is miserable and we see him make an escape to Japan to take care of business. What i love about any notion of Japan and BDSM is the bondage bit – Shibari – and clearly he's a master.

we see this as a tease while he's there playing and i can only hope that we'll get to see more.

So, what we get in this 2nd installment, the bridge book is the cross over from happy newlyweds with Trevor and Elisabeth, to the complexities of Marc and Lauren, to the depression and hope of Roman. It's a nice progression, and i like that these stories aren't really stand alone. you do yourself a disservice if you read them out of order or as stand alones. so.....check them all out and i'm off to book 3 to see what's next for the BAD Boys.

This is the first time I've read something by Shoshanna Evers and I liked it!

This is book number two in the Enslaved Trilogy, although I started to read the series out of order I didn't feel like I missed anything between book one and two, as two stands by itself. Then again, it teased me enough to want to read book one and find out what happened between Trevor and his new wife.

Enamored is the story of two Doms who have been in love with each for EVER but they haven't acted upon it because they're both Doms. Imagine that. A Dom telling wanting to whip another Dom. Yes. This is the case for Marc and Lauren.

Marc is a natural born Dom, whereas Lauren chose to become a Dominatrix after an incident in high school. Marc is tempted by a bet and is willing to risk it all if it means topping Lauren. He's dreamt about dominating her since they met. The problem is, Lauren is too much a Domme and to get her to allow him to top her is almost impossible. But a bet is a bet.

Lauren wants to dominate Marc. The bet is like a dream come true. She's sure she'll win until she loses. Now, she's at Marc's mercy to do with her what he will. She doesn't know what to make of it, but once she has a taste of it, she craves more.

Despite a relentless attraction and friendship, Lauren and Marc know their relationship would never work, because they're both dominants. After a mutual friend suggests Lauren may in fact be a switch, Marc suggests a bet, whereby the loser has to be the winner's sex slave for a week. Frustrated, and convinced she won't lose, Lauren agrees, tempted by the possibility of Marc as her slave and determined to explore if there is anyway a relationship between them could work. When Lauren loses the bet she is horrified but whilst Marc has always been a dominant, Lauren's progression into dominance occurred later – could she learn to loosen her grip on her role for Marc?

Enamored is the second book in the Enslaved trilogy, but I think you could happily read Enamored without having read book 1, Enslaved. I personally preferred Enamored to Enslaved, probably because I liked Mistress Lauren more than Elisabeth. I also felt that the romance was stronger throughout Enamored, and I really cared about both Marc and Lauren, and their relationship. The story came off as lighter than expected though – much more fun and light-hearted than the difficult struggle for control I expected. That's not necessarily a bad thing, particularly since I think this is too short to do a stronger struggle justice. If you're looking for a romance with BDSM elements and a happily ever after, you'll get it – just don't pick this up if you're looking for angst!

The Happily Ever After is a little unconventional, but I think it really works for the story. I can't say any more than that without giving anything away!

I enjoyed Enamored, but in all honesty the first two books have left me feeling like this is actually The Roman Trilogy, rather than a book for each of the BAD boys. I do feel bad for him, but at the same time, I picked up the book expecting to explore Marc's relationship with Mistress Lauren, and then felt Roman dominated a bit too much. I'm looking forward to Enraptured, the final book in the trilogy, because I do want to know how things will work out for Roman, and I expect him to dominate that book!

Enamored brings us back into the lives of the BAD (Billionaire Arrogant Doms) boys, taking up the story

shortly after the end of book 1 Enslave. We have been introduced to both Marc and Lauren in the first book and Enamored takes up their story.

Marc and Lauren have been friend for over 5 years now and have feeling for each other but as they are both the Dominant that doesn't lend itself to any kind of relationship. Fellow BAD boy Roman suggests to Marc that Lauren may have some latent sub tenancies and may be a switch (even if only for him) and gives Marc the idea of winning a bet to prove it to her.

Enamored has less of a dark BDSM edge to it than Enslaved but has more romance and plenty of hot sexy scenes. We learn of the motivations and the pasts from Marc and Lauren and really feel like you get to know the characters. Ms Evers does a fantastic job of tying the books together and keeping the sexual tension going. We are introduced to many aspects of the BDSM lifestyle in a fun, sexy and positive light as well as being entertained and given a wonderful HEA. When last we saw the BAD Boys, Trevor was happily engaged to Elisabeth, Roman was brokenhearted, and Marc was ... uh ... where was Marc again?

Oh, yeah. Marc was there, aiding and abetting his friends. But in Enamored, Marc gets to aid and abet (GET IT?) Mistress Lauren, whom he has lusted over for quite some time.

Marc and Lauren are besties, and, as two Doms, they understand each other. But Marc has a secret wish: he wants to dominate Lauren, and he wants to take their little friendship and escalate it a bit. A really big bit. When the opportunity arises to become romantically involved with her, Marc jumps at it. Granted, the "opportunity" is one he manufactures to his own advantage, but if he didn't, he wouldn't be a BAD Boy, now, would he.

Whereas Enslaved occasionally made too much of Elisabeth's background, Enamored plays all the right notes with Lauren's. The more we get to know her, the more we like her, and the more we want her with Marc. I didn't see Trevor's attraction to Elisabeth, but I sure can see Marc's to Lauren. She's hot, he's hot, and together they claw, rip, snarl, bite, scratch, and bed each other with roaring hot passion.

The sex scenes ... they are goooood. Also good is the story. It doesn't feel as forced as it did with Trevor and Elisabeth, perhaps because Marc and Lauren are far more kindred souls than their friends. Roman's still around and still brooding (WHY? Elisabeth is NOT THAT FABULOUS, Roman!), and we'll get to him in the third installment.

This is the sort of book that you read for its hotness, and it provides quiet nicely. With characters you enjoy and an entertaining story line, it's a good book.

Shoshanna Evers, in my opinion, is the best erotic romance author anywhere. Her recent Enslaved Trilogy is a great example. The three books in order are: Enslaved (book 1), Enamored, (book 2) Enraptured (book 3 which was released yesterday) I am reviewing the entire trilogy. If you enjoy reading about BDSM, or If you just want to know more about the subject, you will love these books. There is a fair amount of kink in each book, but it is always appropriate to the story. The sex is very graphic, but not gratuitous.

However, these books are not just one sex scene after another. Each book tells an exciting page turning story of one of three close friends and business partners Trevor, Marc, and Roman (who all are billionaires) and their very different paths to an authentic relationship with the woman of their dreams. All three are Doms and deep inside are seeking that one special sub that will fulfill their kinks and still be a true lover, but their paths are all VERY different, infinitely challenging for all three and extremely enjoyable for the reader. (I read each one through in one day, including book 3 after it was downloaded to my Kindle yesterday morning from my pre-order.)

Each book can be a standalone, but I recommend, in order to grasp the full impact of the struggles and triumphs that you read them in order. At least start with the first one. This is Trevor and Elizabeth's book. Elizabeth is very sassy and continues to try to top from the bottom. She calls herself a pain slut and disobeys often to receive the punishment she desires. She and Trevor struggle to find an acceptable balance. And Boy do they ever!

Marc and Lauren (book 2) have a totally different story. He is a Dom and she is a Domme, and how they get together is probably the most interesting (and certainly the most challenging story). Great reading. Roman was not my favorite in the first 2 books. Shoshanna told me there would be some big surprises in the third book, and WOW was she right. Now I think Roman is my favorite of the three friends. Jessica is seemingly so totally opposite of who you think Roman is that you will never believe the miracle that happens. What a beautiful ending for the trilogy.

The books are easy reads (roughly in the 160 page range). This is the best length for these stories. (I hate it when the hero/heroine struggle on and on and on with the same baggage or issues ad museum. Shoshanna/s books move quickly.

I am not into the kind of kink that is the heart of these stories; however, there are underlying issues and struggles that have nothing to do with BDSM. These are dilemmas that many of us face every day. This is one of the things that make Shoshanna the best erotic romance author anywhere!

What happens when two people used to taking the dominant role in the bedroom get together for a week and one of them is required to play the submissive?

Author Shoshanna Evers continues the saga of the BAD Boys with Marc's story in *Enamored*. The high energy displayed in the first installment continues where the first one left off, this time focusing on the second of the three BAD boys. While I was intrigued by Marc and Lauren as they tried to figure out who was going to submit, my attention was drawn to Roman, the last of the three BAD Boys. I am anxious to see whether he gets a happily ever after in the next installment.

The storyline moves quickly and effortlessly, drawing the reader into a world where pain and pleasure are one and the same. Marc and Lauren are powerful characters, which is to be expected. My focus was on the interaction between two dominants and how well the author allowed Lauren to maintain her strong character traits. It's not often that a storyline features a Dominatrix, but Lauren's character demonstrated that even a dominant person can enjoy submission — in the right set of circumstances. I also enjoyed cameo appearances by Elisabeth and Trevor, who were the main characters in the first story.

This installment meshed well with the first one, leaving the reader ready for the grand finale. Marc's story serves as a reminder that sometimes bets can have life-changing consequences.

After reading the adventures of Trevor and Elizabeth, and their love triangle with Roman before their engagement, I wanted to know the further adventures of the outrageous Bad Boys. If the first volume was quite daring with the sharing of a woman between two men... There, the story unfold a relationship between two friends: Mark and Lauren.

Honestly, I was a little disappointed by the outcome. Much softer than the first volume, I found it less fun that it might have been. Marc is also a rather romantic Dom. Roman remains the most intriguing character. His trip to Japan is pretty intense... And I can't wait to know Jessica better!

The novel is nice, the writing skills of the author always nice but it lacks a little something that left me a bit hungry for more.
