Twin Text- Froggy Builds a Tree House by Jonathon London, copyright 2011

Selection Rationale- Tadpole to Frog goes through the stages of how a tadpole changes into a frog. This book would be good for the kindergarten and first grade students. The book is simple to read/simple to teach to kids. Froggy Builds a Tree House is a fun picture book to read to young kids. This book has pictures of how a frog looks like while talking about how Froggy builds a treehouse and meets other friends along the way.

Strategy- Tadpole to Frog uses description when describing the vocabulary words. It has captions to describe more about the frog. The book also uses chronological sequence to describe the steps in order. After reading

and discussing Tadpole to frog, students will design their own pictures with the steps in chronological order. Students will label their pictures with one to two words.
