I loved Succumbing to His Fear and thought I would feel the same with this one...unfortunately that was not the case. I was left disappointed, feeling as if the romance between Talon and Tate was overshadowed by all the hoopla surrounding the supporting characters/their families.

While Talon was the bright spot of this book I had higher hopes that, like Alfie and Fear in the first book, we would see more of a progression with him and Tate becoming a couple. Granted both cases are totally insta-love but I wasn't bothered by that. I was bothered by the fact that we kept being told that everything was so great, whether weeks passed, or simply days did. More so, we get the whole "things were going so well I should have known something was going to go wrong" trope. Thus, that is how the last half of the book goes; we get scenario after scenario of convoluted craziness that undercuts any highs Talon and Tate experience.

Like I said, Talon was the stand out for me. He suffers from a severe stutter and as a result of the harsh criticism and verbal abuse he received from his own mother in his childhood, he has chosen to no longer speak at all. It was heartbreaking seeing him constantly struggle with the residual feelings being told he was a "freak," an "embarrassment," and most devastatingly, a "disappointment" has caused. When it comes to being there for his family he is usually able to fight against those voices and be there for them. However, one such instance of being there for his brother, resulted in Talon taking over for a drunken frontman of a band hired to play at his brother's birthday party and singing beautifully. Yes, he is unable to speak but has a voice that garners him tons of YouTube likes and the desire of the band to hire him as their new frontman. This is ultimately the catalyst that causes drama upon drama to ensue. It's also when the story went terribly downhill for me.

Seeing in the beginning how Talon and Tate developed their relationship through the writing of letters back and forth, was so sweet. I wanted more of that connection, that again, didn't just tell us that everything with them-especially with Tate being Talon's first everything-was great, but showed us in ways that wasn't about simply being there for each other while so much happened around them and within their families.

Therefore, this is barely a 3 star read for me.
