Having the freedom to move from state to state, taking odd jobs to get by, she still could not figure out why she wasn't happy. In addition to searching for happiness, she was also in search of a bathroom. When Rochelle realizes a restroom is not anywhere close, she finds herself at the gate of a large house asking a complete stranger if she can use their facilities while a strange wolf stood in the distance watching her. When she finds herself at the front door, she is greeted by one of the most handsome men she has ever seen. Jarrod Freiss was gorgeous and had she not been so desperate to use the restroom, she may have taken more time to get a better look. While I find it odd that a woman would simply drop everything and move in with a group of men that she barely knows, the author makes up for it by showing the tension between them as they explore the relationship without forcing it. Determined to prove their love and devotion, the men are at odds when their Rochelle runs off after hearing some news that makes her question their loyalty. What they were not prepared for, was a lone wolf ready to make his presence known, even if it means taking a life for himself.
