Gabby Pearson is planning to take her slow moving relationship with computer geek Reed Larkin to an intimate level, but he floors her when he unexpectedly breaks up with her. Gabby is absolutely furious, and she makes certain that Reed knows her feelings. Reed is placed in a awkward position the next day when his boss demands that he make up with Gabby. Reed is not exactly what he seems, and his classified job is the reason he met Gabby and then broke off their relationship. Reed has his work cut out for him trying to soothe Gabby's feelings enough to convince her to give him another chance. When Gabby does relent towards Reed, they engage in a few steamy encounters before Reed's charade ends with miserable repercussions. Complicating the situation are coworkers of both Gabby and Reed.
