This was a nice read about twins switching places. Tegan's identical twin Morgan's boss from hell, James Maverick, refuses her request for one week leave to attend her best friend's wedding, Morgan guilts Tegan into standing in for her at the job assuring her with Maverick in Italy she would have an entire week of swanning around in a plush office with nothing more to do than sort the mail and file her nails. As it so happens the Italian client Maverick was meeting has a heart-attack, so he's back Monday morning at the office only to find his P.A. of eighteen months, 'a stickler for time' not in as yet.

Tegan had been delayed by her twin's inquisitive elderly neighbour whose two puppies' enthusiastically paw at her legs leaving her stockings laddered beyond repair, because of which she had to stop at the chemist to purchase a new pair. At the office while at her desk, she first proceeds to don her new stockings little knowing that her twin's boss was already in his office. Transfixed, he watches his PA. who is usually in her hands-off business attire, angling her killer legs upward as she drapes each one with a lace-topped luxury, an image that got etched in his head and wouldn't leave him for the entire book. But then, he had to remind himself that he never looked at his P.As, no matter how great their attributes for a bad experience with one had cured him of that.

Tegan was shocked to see the boss, who was supposed to be in Italy, standing in front of her. Moreover, her sister didn't tell her that her A grade tyrant boss was also an A grade sex on legs. She panics but Maverick, who can't get over the image of her lace covered legs, doesn't realize that it was someone else in his P.A's place, although later, at times, he did wonder how did his meek, mild and restrained PA turn out so sassy and alluring all of a sudden.

Thereafter, the two of them find it difficult to keep their hands off each other. But, Tegan knew she couldn't mess with her sister's boss, so with great difficulty manages to put a distance between them for the entire week. Meanwhile, Maverick's Aussie client, Rogerson, who'd been hesitant about the project after the Italian client's heart attack., is so charmed by Tegan that he agrees to doing the project. She also charms his grandmother,, who was such a character - an adorable one.

Then, Friday evening, when she was trying to escape from Maverick, he tells her they're invited to dinner by Rogerson. Tegan has a little extra drink and throws caution to the wind and ends up sleeping with Maverick. Next morning, when he asks her to spend weekend with him she reluctantly but firmly refuses telling him Monday they'll go back to being Boss & P.A which irks Maverick. However when Tegan reaches home there's a message on her phone from her sister telling her she's broken her leg so bad that it needed surgery and she won't be back for another 3-4 weeks and to continue to impersonate her.

Tegan however decides to come clean with Maverick, on Monday. However, still irked with her, he interrupts her and whisks her off to meet Rogerson, who wants her to be part of their project. After that, Maverick, who can't keep his hands off her anymore proposes a short-term affair, until the attraction they feel for each other runs its course. Tegan, who's been finding it equally hard to keep her distance, succumbs

to his proposition and spends five weeks as his P.A. cum lover, thereby deeper and deeper entangled in her own web of deceit. She meanwhile learns from Maverick about the PA who had deliberately used an inconvenient pregnancy to trick him into marrying her, which he is still very angry about. As luck would have it, she ends up pregnant with his child. Considering the lies she'd told him, she feared Maverick's wrath. And, Maverick blows a fuse when he does find out. By the time, he realizes he loves her he's greeted by the news that she's hospitalized. Fortunately, she doesn't lose the baby.

Although, I did like the book, I found it lacking in intensity. Besides, one has to suspend belief at times while reading it. The characters however were likeable and the book had a fun element to it. The epilogue was very sweet. Overall a light, pleasant read.

Tegan gets roped into filling in for her twin sister at her job since the boss wouldn't clear her personal leave request...so Tegan is acting as Morgan...and Maverick, the boss, has no idea. He certainly realizes something is different, since he's never before felt such an attraction to his PA before. And it most definitely gets in the way of his personal vow never to end up in bed with the underlings again, having been burned in the past. But somehow, Tegan and Maverick end up in a whirlwind affair, lengthened after her sister is injured in an accident and has to be out of work even longer. But when Tegan ends up pregnant and realizes she has to reveal her deception and pregnancy to a man who has claimed to despise liars, she's terrified that he'll push her out of his life before he ever realizes he loves her.

This was at least interesting. Tegan and Maverick had some absolutely killer chemistry and it translates really well on the page. These two practically explode the first time they come together and that's where the real strength in this story is. The central plot circles around a kind of big misunderstanding that just can never get cleared up because of all these little circumstances that prevent it. And that's truly Tegan's excuse for not telling the truth earlier - that she'd mean to tell him and something would come up that would require her to continue her deception, like her sister's accident, or Rogerson's needing her in on the deal... But I'm kind of with Maverick on this one, that excuse is not a good one. When one is being that dishonest, has fallen in love with the person they're lying to and also pregnant - it's time to spill the beans, no matter what it takes. Oddly enough, it's the fact that she delayed telling him about the pregnancy that really pissed him off...and the fact that she was pregnant in the first place. The fact that he'd been sleeping with a woman for 7 weeks without knowing her real name never really seemed to bother him. But Maverick most definitely gets pissed and says some pretty cruel things. But Tegan was feeling her share of the guilt so ends up understanding where his anger and venom are coming from. So the "grovel" was kind of on both their sides and wasn't particularly satisfying since both of them were really in the wrong. The epilogue was a bit on the saccharine sweet side, but a nice inclusion to the story.
