This was a pretty good story. Emily, Gabe and Noah make a good trio and I liked their story. This is the first story I've read by this author and based on this I'll probably read book #2 in the series when it comes out.

Emily is 23 years old and a successful author. She's actually been writing since her teens and all the way through college and she's done well for herself. She doesn't have much in the way of family anymore but she has friends she cares about. The most important are Gabe and Noah, her 2 best friends whom she's known since she was very young.

Gabe and Noah have been close since they were very young. They made friends with Emily when she was young as well and became her friends and protectors. The three of them have stayed very close throughout the years, even while Gabe and Noah joined the service and then were recruited into the FBI. In the FBI, Gabe and Noah head up a task force that goes after predators (usually ones going after the young).

When the story begins, Emily has been having issues with a stalker for about 2 months. She has closed herself away and stayed away from her friends because she's afraid the stalker will hurt anyone she's close to. She doesn't tell them partially because she's afraid to distract them while

She packs up and leaves without telling anyone, trying to leave her stalker behind or at least lead him away from the people she cares about. Gabe and Noah show up at home and when they can't find Emily, they begin to worry. Soon they find out what she's been going through and are determined to find her and protect her.

Obviously, the boys find Emily and protect her. I will warn you that since they've all been in love with each other (well, there's no m/m) since they were kids, their relationship pretty much is instant as soon as the guys tell Emily they both want her. She's never dated much due to her loving Gabe and Noah so she very innocent (yeah, V-card) but wants to explore it all with them. There are some difficulties though. Some come in the form of Emily not being herself after being hounded by a stalker for months and it takes a bit for her to be able to truly interact with Gabe and Noah in a healthy way for their relationship to grow well.
