There is a strong chance that coming to Vegas was the worst mistake she's ever made but it's also possible that the No Prisoners and Lucky are the family she's always wanted.

I am quickly discovering that I am indeed a fan of the No Prisoners MC series. While I've only read a few books (including this one) about these boys, I have to say I've enjoyed them and can't wait for more. They're a great combination of romance, humor, intrigue and action. There is a great group of characters, both MC members and Ol' Ladies and it's easy to be sucked into their stories.
