Having grown up in Germany, I am familiar with Greece and the island of Santorin as a popular holiday destination, although I have never been there myself. The book transported me there and had me falling in love with the setting. The many settings are one of the strengths of the book, coming alive and feeling like a virtual holiday. It made the book a great read for a relaxing Sunday.

What made this book special is the sensitive way the romance was handled. Usually you have the hero and heroine meet on day one, fall instantly in love or lust on day two, and hop into bed on day three. This story is different. Paul and Sophie get to know and grow to love each other slowly and face many hurdles along the way. That made the love story feel authentic, albeit sometimes a little old-fashioned.
