As has seemed to be pretty much par the course with anything Robinson writes with Ellis, *Herculean* is a ton of fun, continuing many of the exploits of the original Chess Team, but also managing to be its own complete, standalone story.

And a good story it is. Sure some of the nonstop, over the top action that is usually in Robinson's novels is dialed back a bit, replaced with more history and ancient fictional characters, but that makes this a far more deep, compelling story, reminiscent and similar to many of James Rollins's *Sigma Force* novels.

That is the premise of this fine adventure novel, written by Jeremy Robinson and Sean Ellis, and narrated by Jeffery Kafer.
