Katla, MacKenzie's kitchen maid, was long the object of a search for a husband by the MacKenzie but she wasn't a maid any longer and has stated her intention to remain unmarried. Katla danced with the Lord of Winter one winter night two years previously on Odin's Fire and would have no other. Then she meets Gunnar MacLeod and learns the truth.

This story left me feeling as if I was dancing in the Northern Lights with the Lord of Winter and enjoying it (and I hate winter). You could feel the lights swirling around the young couple as they stood on Odin's Flame. The presence of a faithful dog in the story is a trademark of the author and only enhances the story. It included Devorgilla, that wily woman present in so many stories who likes to cause mischief to mere mortals. This is one story of several in the latest Scrolls of Cridhe collection; I'm anxious to read the rest.

Maggie this stranger this sweet Scottish elder lady whom with a little prodding Maggie open heart hears and cries in this old ladies arms. After having a good cry Gertrude asks if she would like to have someone else's life and that she can make it happen plus Maggie would also be doing a bit of good too. Of course Maggie thinks this sweet old Scottish lady is a bit touched in the head and the charming lady know it too. She gives Maggie a pocket watch and says she will be going at least a hundred years in the past and must sleep with the pocket watch there are a few other rules but I do not want to spoil the read for the book lets just say it a wee bit of a Cinderella effect or possibly The Wizard of Oz click those ruby slippers there no place like home or maybe not? Of course Maggie being a health professional want to get this poor woman professional help! So they make a deal if Maggie wakes up in her bed the lady says she will be the Grounds for Sculpture at the same exact time the following day and can get her Psychiatric help. It is also interesting a bit sad when Maggie asks what happens to the person who she would be whose life she would be taking over and switching places with but the result would be the same whether she would switch places or not so no reason for Maggie to feel guilty as the results would be the same whether she agrees to this or not. I also loved the 21st century word to come home which we all use will make the readers laugh, it's brilliant!!

Obviously Maggie releases it she is on a horse that throws her at neck-break speed which throw her and is being told off by the hero in a dress of this story one Scottish lad by the name of Logan Carr. Evidently the Lass she is taking the place is not very nice and the entire clan dislikes her including her betrothed! So what has Maggie gotten herself into? It is really a fabulous fun read to see how this plays out which I am not going to spoil for you. I really loved the secondary character of Logan's mother and grandmother and an appearance of characters from one of Ceci's previous books too! The hero of this story is about Laird and healer Malcolm MacLeod who has not been happy since his betrothed Julie ended and for someone much below his station a bookkeeper from Edinburgh and as if that not enough his brothers and father want to start a war over it and force Julia to marry him. Malcolm and Julia

had been betrothed since childhood but he does not want to force anyone to marry him. He wants to be wanted and plus the face clan do not start wars over broken betrothals as in the days of old and of he doesn't go to war his father has threatened to take the lairdship away and give to one of his two warrior brothers.

Both Esmé and Malcolm are having dreams of each other yet they have never met and love far from each other. Esme has never been interested in other men as they all looked grey to her and the voices come have a meaning as does an old crone to guide them. Both Malcolm and Esmé believe in the old ways and their beliefs plus the way Esmé seems to be able to read animals thoughts and is a healer as well. Though not as experienced as Malcolm though Malcolm's big hand get in the way when healing anyhow small when they do finally meet it is quite beautiful. As they both follow their dreams and voices without question and go on this magical journey to basically save Scotland!
