Each story in this series will read as a standalone. The story is a clean historical situated in Canada with a great cast of characters and plenty of humor. This story will take the reader on a journey of discovery and will bring the con-artist and law enforcement together in marriage.

Colleen Hennessey has reached the ripe old age of twenty-six, making her an old-maid in the eyes of many. After her older sister, Molly chose not to become a Nun like their mother insisted and instead went to Miss Hazel and was matched with Easton, Colleen has considered doing the same. Especially now that their mother wants her to join the sisterhood, so she is ready to take the plunge too.

“You’re a formidable woman. You’re strong, independent, and have the energy of a thoroughbred colt. Seems to me, most men what exactly what Mr. Albury wants you to be—meek, quiet, docile. That’s just not you.”

Colleen is the type of person who has never met a stranger, and isn't afraid to talk to people and is especially outgoing. Her kindness and being helpful to a guest will get her in trouble at work, but it will also be the push for seeking out Miss Hazel.

"I swear I'll be faithful and good-natured and follow the Good Books' teachings on being a proper wife. And I'll give him as many children as he wants. I would love a big family, like the one I grew up in. He'd hardly have to lift a finger. "

Marshall Bowman had never really considered marriage, raised by a single mother and never knowing his father; he has not had an example of what a husband or father should be. When Colleen steps off the train and comes running up to him and hugs him, he is forever lost. But that doesn't mean he keeps from having doubts. Why does he leave Colleen feeling confused, as if he doesn't want her there?

"I know you don't have much experience with the opposite sex, so let me assure you, your husband is absolutely dazzled by you. So much so that he might be temporarily blinded. Sometimes we must lead our men to where we know they want to go, even if they don't know it yet." –Miss Hazel

The story takes on the danger of what the Mounties must handle, including helping when lost individuals, missing items, flooding, blizzard conditions, and even crime. Knowing that there is a gang of men robbing trains will keep them on alert. When they strike White Fox's station, it won't be without someone being hurt. That adds to Marshall's fears for Colleen. He is a man who says the wrong thing, or doesn't say something when he should that hurts his wife's feelings and boy does he suffer several cases of foot-in-mouth disease.

The story will take on a life and death situation that will require teamwork and trust. It will have Marshall realize that the most important person in his life, his wife, Colleen is, and he will boldly prove himself.
