This is a preview comic. Just like a movie preview, there is just enough there to hopefully get you interested enough to buy the rest. (I did download this for free.) It runs less than thirty pages and some of those are ads.

The story was a nice start. I enjoyed the way they told the basic origins of both at the same time. We all know these bits so it was nice to see it presented in a new way. The small ways that were used to show the different approaches of the two heroes was handled nicely as well. The double cliffhanger (yes, two major plot points are left hanging) should definitely make the reader want to continue the story.

I felt the artwork was decent but looked like it belonged in a cartoon at times.

Since it was free, you can't go wrong on the price. But it is not something that you necessarily need in your collection. Finally, don't read thinking that this will set you up for the movie. It really isn't connected. I would rate this as 3 stars due to its short length without really giving away any new information and artwork that didn't thrill me.
