Carter's friend Jason saw Chris take Maddy and is hot on their pursuit. Things take a turn for the worse and Chris crashes the car. Both are taken to the hospital and Jason's day only gets harder as he finds Carter hurt and bleeding. Chris is arrested, and both Maddy and Carter are on the mend. But there was another casualty in the accident...

Jason and Nicole, Maddy's friend, hooked up on New Year's Eve. Jason left Nicole before she woke up the next day as he has huge commitment issues. His sister died years ago and as a result his mom walked out on him and his dad. He won't risk his heart again. These two are thrown in each other's paths because of these events and both can't stay away from each other.
