Deadly Target is the third book in Laurie Roma's IAD Agency series. I have been fortunate to read all three and like a fine wine, Ms. Roma and her IAD agents only get better with time. Deadly Target has everything you want or need in a romance novel – a good storyline, romance, and a great cast of entertaining characters.

There are so many reasons to recommend Deadly Target. Let's start with the hero and heroine. I love that Ms. Roma's heroines are kick-ass, independent women who can still be feminine and vulnerable. Mikayla is a trained sniper who works for an international spy agency. Yet she still comes across as believable and not just a James Bond wanabee. She is one tough cookie and makes no apologies about it, but she is so accustomed to living in a masculine-dominated world that she is worried that no man will ever be able to understand or accept her for who she is. I can only imagine that this is a typical concern of many women in male-dominated professions.

Gage is the perfect man for Mikayla. Mikayla needs an alpha male that she can respect, but someone who is not intimidated by her. That is exactly who Gage is. In fact, instead of being threatened by the fact that Mikayla is a better shot than he is, Gage is impressed and just a little bit turned on. His confidence in his own masculinity allows Mikayla to be herself.

Another reason that I love the IAD series is the secondary characters. Each one has his, or her, own back story that I am certain will appear in later books. Together these men and women of the IAD have created their own family unit filled with love and laughter. Every time they get together, the scenes are so funny that I find myself laughing out loud. When reading a romance, I am often jealous because the heroine gets to be with such an amazing man. This time I am jealous of the relationship that Mikayla has with the others in the agency. Ms. Roma has done an amazing job of establishing a believable, relatable relationship amongst the IAD agents.

Ms. Roma's writing just gets better with each book. I love how she breaks up serious sections with bursts of humor, even when lives are at stake. Humor is a way many of us deal with stressful situations and the banter between the members of the IAD agency fit perfectly with each individual's personality. The affection between Mikayla and her adopted family is evident in the teasing but caring way they take care of each other.

Deadly Target can certainly be read as a standalone. However, once you have read this one, I would bet that you will go back and read the others in the series. And if you have not read any book in this series, then you are definitely missing out. I swear each IAD novel is my favorite until the next one comes out. Now my biggest problem is deciding who I want as the hero of Ms. Roma's next book – should it be Slade or those delightfully yummy twins Adrian and Rock? Whomever she chooses, I just hope it's soon!
