From the first book I read by author Jackie Ashenden I was impressed with the way she spun her story, her multi faceted characters, and the fact that she wasn't afraid to dive into topics that a lot of people tend to shy away from. Her writing is bold, her stories sometimes uncomfortable, and usually have me asking WTF multiple times while reading but I love that because romance isn't always pretty; in fact often it is messy and difficult and Ms. Ashenden is the master of writing messy and difficult. Living In Secret is the third book in this series and it is the best to date; a second chance story of two people on the brink of divorce who find themselves in an unusual situation and feeling things they have never felt before.

This is one of those books where the couple was all kinds of FUBAR; they married because neither one of them wanted someone who was going to get too close, they didn't share big things from their lives before they met, and when they had sex it was less than stellar with both of them holding back. On the outside they were this perfect power couple but at home they were two strangers living in the same house. Like I said FUBAR! When Victoria sees Connor in court one day she sees something in him that moves her and she wants him with a passion; a passion she doesn't want to share with him or admit to so she decides divorce is the only answer only Connor refuses to sign the papers until he gets one week with her for them to explore every naughty thing they've never shared.

I'm not going to lie these two have some issues they haven't dealt with and for some reason the pending divorce and Connor's refusal to sign the papers has them both pushing each other's buttons up to and including acting very out of the normal for the public personas they've both so carefully crafted. Watching them discover and see the real person underneath, stripping themselves bare both physically and emotionally, and opening up to each other in a way they never did during the six year marriage was sometimes difficult to watch and at other times a thing of beauty. The fantasies they shared and acted upon were amazingly hot, often out of control, and wonderfully revealing not only to the two of them but to the reader as well.

As they bare their souls and more it becomes evident that their feelings run way deeper than they ever thought possible sending Victoria running and making Connor more determined than ever for them to work on being together. Like I said, this isn't an easy romance and their sexy times are often angry but I believe

that stems from the passion they have both held inside so long for each other and the need they both have for control.

Emotionally charged, undeniably sexy, a wee bit kinky, and two people finally finding someone who loves them just the way they are makes *Living in Secret* one of author Jackie Ashenden's best books to date.

The whole arrangement was kinda intense because there were a lot of unresolved issues between them, and both Connor and Vic were stubborn af (me reading: JUST TALK TO EACH OTHER U IDIOTSSSSS!!), but I super enjoyed the angsty rollercoaster ride.

In this scorching erotic romance, we are treated to the story of Connor and Victoria. They've been separated for a year and are on the verge of divorce but Connor can't make himself sign the papers, even though their marriage more of convenience than anything and harboring secrets that shattered their illusion of happiness isn't capable of being revived. But one night in the presence of his soon-to-be ex wife shatters his reserve when she shows up at a party as a sexy, sultry woman he doesn't recognize. And when she taunts him with another man, Connor's plans change. He wants one week of this woman, the one he's never seen before, and then he'll agree to the divorce. But once they've had a taste of the passion hidden from each other for so long, will they be able to go their separate ways?

If there is one thing I've come to expect from this author, it's that she has a no holds barred approach to pulling the reader in from the start and presenting them with a tense, emotional, erotic journey from the first page onward. Connor and Victoria are so not perfect for each other in the guises they presented in their

marriage, but now that it's almost over, their true selves are coming to the forefront and the sexual attraction they feel for each other as this happens threatens to overwhelm them both. Their first time together post separation happens with a third party, sexy handsome Raphael, who understands his role is to be an extra serving to buffer Connor and Victoria as they realize what they've been missing all this time. The sex scenes are explosive, sensual and harsh as they fall into roles they never would have when married. Connor gives as good as Victoria takes, though she ultimately has the power in the decision of staying or going at the end of the night, in their week long quest to get each other out of their systems and move on. They both have secrets that prevented them from fully engaging in their marriage but somehow, in this new and fragile peace they've established they have the trust finally needed to open their souls to each other thus establishing a new and so much better relationship than before. When their week of satiation is completed, the decision to move forward with the divorce or back into each other's arms is not taken lightly by either party, but suffice it to say the happy ending is worth the wait. This is one of those stories that will keep you engaged into the wee hours of the night and leave you fully satisfied and eagerly awaiting the next release from this author. 5 steamy and emotional stars!

This is the best book of the series by quite a long run.

I think it helps that this couple are currently still married but were in a loveless, marriage of convenience that worked for what they thought they wanted out of life.

After a year separation initiated by Victoria, she has now asked for a divorce however Connor is not yet ready to give up on their marriage.

Both are holding secrets close to their hearts, and after a clash of wills and in noticing that there is a lot more of the other hidden between the surface, Connor suggests a week of no holds barred sex before he will sign the divorce papers.

Neither expect to share their secrets, let alone for the feelings that pop up to get in the way and for things to get more complicated. There are many layers to their story that come out and as these are stripped away you just know that they are perfect for each other.

Living in Secret is the third installment of the Living In Series by Jackie Ashenden and it brings us Conner &

Veronica's story.

Both Connor and Veronica practice law, after a few years of marriage Veronica wanted out. After a yearlong separation, Connor still refuses to sign the divorce papers, but yet allowed her to walk away. A loveless and passionless marriage held them captive for years, but now that they are on the brink of freedom, a desire is burning deep. Things fell apart when Connor learned a secret that Veronica kept for eighteen years, but she isn't the only one hiding something.

In order to get the divorce that Veronica so desperately wants, she agrees to a one week arrangement with Connor. A chance for him to finally have in all the ways they both refused for so long. But giving in to their desires strips them of their masks and for the first time their secrets are exposed. Conservative, put together, restraint... these labels no longer exist as they give into their fantasies.

I have to say I was not too sure about this one. The prior two were okay reads, nothing that really blew me away – but this one ended up being the best of the series. I loved it. I loved the dynamic of these two – the concept of a separated couple finding their way back to one another. Not just a couple that drifted apart, but a couple that originally sought each other out for the safety of marriage without love, without the risk of being hurt – without the risk of making choices that would destroy the other person. A second chance romance with a twist.

I was trying to piece together just how these two ended up married in the first place, but as they reveal their secrets, it becomes obvious. The author did a great job showing you this rather than just laying all the cards on the table right away.

Once Connor gives into his desires, he becomes a dirty-talking alpha-male. The control and way he took Veronica was off the charts hot. I think the fact that these two shared years in a marriage that lacked any passion made this all feel a bit hotter.

The ending wrapped up a little quickly, but I was okay with that. It allowed the time they spent during their arrangement to last longer and be more detailed. I almost didn't pick this up when the opportunity for an ARC came up. I am very glad I didn't give up on this series and if Raphael is up in the next book, I won't even hesitate to start that one.
