Since then Erica had been unable to get inside a car or cross the street at certain intersections. I understood the phobia of driving, but the author took it too far with her unable to be in a car or near a car. Then the issue with crossing busy intersections made no sense since the accident involved hitting a deer not another car or pedestrians.

Adam arrived to Astoria to work the summer at a motorcycle shop. The first day he arrived he met Erica. It's an insta-summer connection story involving two people desperate to move forward in life. Both want to run away from their current lives and start anew. Adam is running away from his past in Sacramento.

With the help of a frightened cat Erica meets Adam. A quick bond keeps them interacting with each other until they get lost in each other's arms.

The words have yet to make me believe this connection between Erica and Adam. I'm not feeling the emotional attachment. I felt a disconnect with the characters. The story contained too many unnecessary details. The story was stagnant in the beginning not progressing much.

It's not clear what the author was striving for with the normal teenager comment. I don't understand the need for such a lengthy story. For a summer fling it sure was taking a long time to reveal its story. The story had too many plots that bogged it down.

This is the debut novel of the writer. As a first novel, it is not bad but it is not perfect, either.

There are two young people at the age of 18. Both are broken for different reasons. The way they clicked and connected was too sudden and the way their feelings got intense was not so convincing. I see the point here was "loving each other broken" but it was too insta-love.

First, I wasn't OK with how the hero tried to push her away and how much she pursued him but when I learnt his secret (plot twist), I understood him, he had valid reasons to do so.

The book takes a while to get through it because there is too much in it - too many details, too many other people and stuff.

The romance between the couple is drowned amidst the family drama of the heroine, her PTSD, befriending with the angry cat and taming it, heroine's healing of her PTSD, hero's friend and his economic problems, heroine's friend and her relationship problems, a customer and her dog and more.

The hot scenes are limited. And the emotional part of the story turns into a depressing and sad one after the plot twist. The hero's secret makes the book more and more depressing. I had to skip a lot and skim through the last quarter of the book as I don't like to read about that plot twist - a trigger of mine, unfortunately.

The ending is a broken happy end, as a result of the hero's problem, but still they are together, don't worry about that.
