The author used too many adjectives for my liking. The language in general was an issue for me. Denison's grammar was fine but the word choices got me, words that either turned me off or seemed unsuited, unflattering, personally incompatible or generally incongruous for the situation. I stress that these were things for me, not necessarily for everyone. As a consequence though, I didn't really enjoy the sex. There was no current conflict between Faith and Matthew. The barriers were based on Faith's past and rumours about Matthew. Because of this I found the story a little flat. I never felt much of a spark between them, at least not one I got excited about. The whole story ended up a little clichéd and overly perfect by the end. It just wasn't for me.
