I really enjoyed this installment. The story line was humorous as well as involving – Grandpa Peck was a real hoot – and the interaction between the three boys and Pete's grandpa was cute.

Not a bad mystery, but the later ones just don't seem as good as the earlier volumes. Part of that is probably just familiarity but also I think the steam was just slowly leaking out of the series.

This one was pretty interesting as the boys take a car trip from California to New York, making several stops in between. It was a nice travelogue in a way as the various tourist spots and restaurants they visit along the way are named. The main plot involves Pete's grandfather bringing an invention from the West Coast to the East Coast, and the sneaks trying to steal the invention before he gets there. Or are they? That's where the mystery comes in. There's also a subplot with a biker gang that I thought could have been better explained.

Overall not a bad read, and the settings really made this one.
