I have had this series on my TBR for a while now. I guess since the release of this first book in the series. And just before starting UNFORGETTABLE SUMMER is when I realized that the Ty in the blurb was the same Ty from Sami Lee's the Bandicoot Cove: The Wedding story MOONLIGHT MIRAGE. When I finished that story I desperately wanted him to have his own story but I never linked him to this book. If I had, I would have read UNFORGETTABLE SUMMER much sooner than now.

I did have certain expectations of the story once I realized it was Ty Butler's story and unfortunately the book didn't fully meet those expectations. For one I thought the book would be dirtier, sexier but though it was pretty explicit and sexy it was also very sweet and it felt like Ty was holding back somehow because it was Summer. There were times he treated her as the virginal innocent she was ten years earlier and though there's nothing wrong with that, it didn't quite work for me, especially the virgin role-playing thing didn't.

I did like the backstories and the history between Ty and Summer. Though I am not a fan of story-telling through flashbacks they did work for me in this book. It served to add depth to the characterization of both Summer and Ty and didn't interfere with the pace of the rest of the story. I really liked the ending. It was less focused on the proper, conservative Summer and became more emotional, giving me the lump-in-throat ending I always love.

UNFORGETTABLE SUMMER is a sweet, emotional, sort of reunited first love story. It was enjoyable with plenty of heat and I look forward to reading the other books in the series.

And while Ty Butler was brave enough to do this in his professional life, his personal life is another story. He never quite got over the shy, innocent Summer Campbell that tore his heart in two. Torn apart by Ty's burgeoning career and Summer's loyalty to her family seeing each other after 10 years the one thing they can't deny is the intense attraction and heat they still feel for one another.

The first thing I thought when these two meet again after so much time is how different their lives are and how little in common they seem to have. There was no doubting the sexual chemistry so when they decide to embark on a "fling" to "get it out of their system; it seemed like a good idea, right? A decade of suppressed feelings and a lust that was never extinguished, has Summer's blood pumping hard and fast at the very first sight of her lost love, but common sense has her running for the hills in an attempt to save what little remains of her shattered heart.

Ty believes Summer untouchable, as he has kept track of this elusive woman over time and knows that she married; but an undeniable magnetism has him seeking her out to discover if the depth of what he felt all those years ago, was really as profound as his young heart thought.

Unforgettable Summer is a well written story that keeps a steady pace from beginning to end and captures the readers full attention. And while Ms Lee has written two very different characters, they succeed in complimenting each other in a fundamental way. Ty is fun, easy going and loves life. He also has never forgotten the attraction that drew him to Summer and wants nothing more than to pursue what they could have had; while Summer is delicate soul, wounded on so many fronts, lacking in self confidence and afraid to allow a buried love to resurface and crush her all over again.

But passion will not be denied, so this disillusioned couple embark on what's suppose to be a purely physical relationship for the short time Ty is in town, but when the sun rises on his last day, will they again be able to bury the love that has blossomed and consumed them both as Ty leaves for his next big wave?

Golden beaches and endless summers, surfers and all-consuming passion, welcome to the Australian way of life.
